Subject: Revised procedure for submission of bills for payments/recoveries
in respect of urea under new Pricing Policy for urea units.

Sir,

Consequent upon the issue of Govt. of India, Ministry of Chemicals and Fertilisers (Dept. of Fertilizers)'s letter No. 12019/5/98-FPP dated 30th January, 2003 on formulation of a new Pricing Policy for urea units, it has become necessary to revise the existing procedure for payment/recoveries under Retention Price Scheme and to modify the same under the new scheme.

2. It has been decided that, in modification of Govt. of India, Ministry of Chemicals & Fertilisers' letter No. 4(27)/80-FDA-I dated 29th September, 1980, No. 4(20)/84-FDA-I dated 6.5.1985, No. 12019/12/98-FPP-II dated 26th October, 1998, No. 12012/21/99-FPP-II dated 24.7.2002 and No. 12012/21/99-FPP-II dated 3.9.2002, the following procedure will now govern the payments to be made to the manufacturers or credits to be afforded by the later to the Government of India w.e.f. 1st April, 2003 under the new scheme:-

- i) The reimbursement of the difference between the rate of concession under the new scheme as notified by the Government from time to time and the net realization (notified sale price of urea minus the dealers' margin) as notified by the Government for both the urea allocated under Essential Commodities Act (ECA) and non-ECA shall be payable to the urea manufacturers on the quantities of urea moved out of the factory for sale for agricultural purposes w.e.f. 1.4.2003 and onwards, on a monthly basis. The payment shall be made within a maximum period of 60 days from the date of receipt of the claim, complete in all respects.
- ii) Units whose rates of concession under the new scheme for urea (both under ECA or non-ECA) are lower than the net realization (notified sale price of urea minus the dealers' margin) w.e.f. 1.4.2003 shall have to deposit the differential amount due from them, representing the difference between the net realization and the rate of concession to the credit of the Fertilizer Industry Coordination Committee (FICC). The amounts to be credited shall be calculated on the basis of the entire quantities of urea moved out of the factory for sale in a given calendar month w.e.f. 1.4.2003. The amount shall be paid within a period of 45 days from the date of notification in question by a crossed cheque or demand draft payable at New Delhi in favour of Pay and Accounts Officer, Deptt. Of Fertilisers. Delayed credits shall attract interest @ 3% p.a. above the State Bank of India's (SBI) Prime Lending Rate (PLR). As and when the SBI lowers or raises the PLR by one per cent or more, the office of FICC would check the


prevailing rates on 1st April and 1st October every year coinciding with the Kharif and Rabi season and take appropriate action to revise the rates accordingly.

- iii) The manufacturers of urea entitled to claim reimbursement, shall submit their bills, in duplicate in the proforma at **Annexure I**, complete in all respects. The manufacturers who are required to afford credit, shall submit their bills, in duplicate, in the proforma at **Annexure V**.
- iv) The monthly details shall be further supplemented by annual certificates from the Statutory Auditors to be sent to the FICC with the bill for the month of March each year in the Proforma at **Annexure III**, in the case of units claiming payment and in the Proforma at **Annexure VII**, in the case of units affording credit, authenticating total production, dispatches and closing balance etc. of urea under ECA or non-ECA separately during the year ending 31st March. Since manufacturers are facing difficulties in obtaining the Annual Annexure immediately after March every year and verification from Statutory Auditors which will be completed by June of every year, hence, it has been decided that these certificates, in duplicate, shall be submitted along with the June claims positively. The claims for June onwards shall not be entertained for payment if annual **Annexure III or VII** are not submitted with June claims.
- v) The monthly claims shall be supported by the details, in duplicate, in the Proforma at **Annexure II**, in the case of urea units claiming payments and in the proforma at **Annexure VI**, in the case of units affording credits.

- vi) The monthly bills both for payments/recoveries and statement at Annexure II/Annexure VI shall be signed by an officer not below the rank of General Manager or the Finance Director. The specimen signatures of the persons authorized to sign the bills etc . would accordingly be required to be sent to the FICC either before the submission of the bills or along with the first bill as per the procedure already followed in this regard.
- vii) The bills shall continue to be forwarded to the Executive Director, FICC, 8th floor, Sewa Bhawan, R.K.Puram, New Delhi. 110066.
- viii) A detailed check of the payments/recoveries made under the new Scheme and that of all the records maintained by the fertilizer units in respect of production/dispatches and closing balances for each product together with their supporting documents and such other records as may be required by the inspection parties, would be exercised by inspection parties to be deputed for the purpose from the FICC or any other authority under the Government, at periodic intervals. In this connection, the following records, which are at present being maintained by the fertilizer units, shall continue to be maintained and kept ready for checking by the inspection parties:-
- a) Daily stock register in form RG-I showing for each day, the opening balance, production, quantity dispatched under ECA & Non-ECA separately and closing balance, separately for good, sub-standard and sweepings of urea. Each entry in the RG-I shall be attested by the authorized officer of the unit.

- b) Daily reports of production and stock separately for good, substandard and sweepings of urea duly authenticated by Manager (Production).
 - c) Despatch/stock transfer advices serially numbered and signed by Manager (Sales).
 - d) Despatch instructions issued from Headquarters or other controlling agency.
 - e) Gate Passes, bearing printed serial number, time of dispatch etc. shall be issued separately for urea under ECA and Non-ECA.
 - f) In the same manner, the Register of Gate Passes showing number and date of issued gate passes and quantities moved out of the factory (i.e. the daily recapitulation statement) should also be maintained separately for urea under ECA and Non-ECA.
 - g) Register of dispatches giving full particulars of gate pass number, date, dispatch/stock transfer advice and number and date of the letter containing dispatch instructions, against each entry in the register.
3. The proforma for claiming Sales Tax on inputs used for manufacturing urea under the new scheme will be circulated in due course.
4. The above procedure is subject to review from time to time.
5. This issues with the concurrence of the Finance Division (Ministry of Chemicals & Fertilizers) vide their U.O. No. 836/FA/03 dated 24.4.2003.


