2. Due to application of the outlier methodology, some units are eligible for lower rate of concession and as such though they are allowed to claim as per general industry average to maintain uniformity, the amount not payable to them on the quantity of the finished fertilizer/ raw materials/ intermediates covered under the outlier concept will be deducted by the Department of Fertilizers as follows:

3. The recovery due to the outlier on account of DAP will be adjusted against the Head of Account meant for imported DAP. The recovery due to outlier on account of usage of Ammonia and Sulphur will be adjusted against the Head of Accounts relating to payment of concession for NPK complex fertilizers. All other recoveries due to adjustments between the final rates for April, May and June 2009 and the prevailing Base rates would be as per the relevant head of Accounts.

4. In case the amount of concession payable to a particular manufacturer/importer in a particular month, is less than the amount recoverable, the balance amount will be recovered from the concession payable from the immediate subsequent month(s).

5. The State/UT Governments are requested to expedite pending the certification of receipts of fertilizers to enable the Department of Fertilizers for processing and making payment of concession in respect of the outstanding claims of manufacturers/importers of P&K fertilizers. The State / UT Governments are also requested to ensure that the fertilizers on which concession is claimed, are sold by the manufacturers/importers at the indicative MRP announced by the Government.

6. This issues in concurrence with the Ministry of Finance, Department of Expenditure vide their ID No. 6(12) PF II / 2005 dated 16.3.2010 and the Internal Finance Division (IFD) of this Department vide AS&FA's Dy. No. 503/2010 dated 26th March 2010.
