2. Since the final rates of concession in the month of September 2008 are higher than the base rates w.e.f 1st April 2008, the base rates originally announced will continue to be effective.

3. Due to application of the 'outlier' methodology, some units are eligible for lower rate of concession and as such, though they are allowed to claim as per general industry average to maintain uniformity, the amount not payable to them on the quantity of finished fertilizer/raw materials/intermediates covered under the outlier concept will be deducted as follows:

Finished Fert/ Raw Material/Intermediate	September 2008
DAP	Deduction from IPL = Rs. "33762833.46"
Ammonia	Deduction from IFFCO = Rs. "203226358.49"
Sulphur	Deduction from CFL = Rs. "13110284.07"

4. The recovery on account of DAP will be adjusted against the Head of Accounts meant for Imported Phosphatic Fertilizers/DAP. The recovery on account

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of usage of Ammonia will be adjusted against the Head of Accounts relating to payment of concession for complex fertilizers.

5. In case the amount of concession payable to a particular manufacturer/importer in a particular month is less than the amount recoverable as above, the balance amount will be recovered from the concession payable from the immediate subsequent month.

6. The provisional final rates of concession for month of September 2008 for the new NPKS being produced / proposed to be produced by the following units shall be as follows:

7. The above-mentioned manufacturers of Complex Fertilizers will be eligible to claim 'on account' payment of concession on the sales/receipts of the said Complex Fertilizers at the rate of 85% (90% with Bank Guarantee) of the rates indicated above.

8. The State/UT Governments are requested to expedite pending sales certificates/ certification of receipts of fertilizers to enable processing and payment of the outstanding claims of manufacturers/importers of P&K fertilizers. The State / UT Governments are also requested to ensure that the fertilizers on which concession is claimed are sold at the indicative MRP announced by the Government.

9. This issues with the approval of Department of Expenditure (Ministry of Finance) and the concurrence of the IFD vide Dy. No. 2201/AS&FA/2008 dated 27.11.2008.


