**Sub:** Final rates of concession month-wise from April to September 2007 and Base Rate of concession with effect from October 2007 on the sales/receipts of decontrolled P & K fertilizers (DAP, MOP and NPK Complexes) in the States/districts during the year 2007-08.

Madam/Sir,

In continuation of this Department's letter No.22011/5/2007-MPR dated 10.07.2007 announcing the Base Rate for 2007-08 and No. 5-1/2007-Shipping II/MPR dated 12.09.2007 with respect to the continuation of the Concession Scheme on decontrolled P&K fertilizers for the year 2007-08, I am directed to say that the monthly Final Rates of Concession for the period, April to September 2007 in respect of DAP (indigenous), DAP (imported), MOP and NPK Complexes for the year 2007-08 (except IFFCO Kandla unit) shall be as follows:-

2. Consequent upon the removal of restriction on concession for Indigenous DAP Group I capped by the concession payable to Group II w.e.f 1<sup>st</sup> April 2007 for 2007-08, the final claims of companies using captive phosphoric acid and imported phosphoric acid routes will be settled in proportion to their production of DAP through the different routes. Final concession rates for indigenous DAP Group I units are lower for the months of June and July 2007 and final concession rates for indigenous DAP Group II units are lower for the months of April, May, August and September 2007. Accordingly, the final claims of M/s HIL (Group I) and M/s PPL, SPIC and TCL (Group II) will be settled in proportion to the production of DAP made by these companies through the different routes.

3. The final rates for IFFCO Kandla unit shall be announced separately. The final rates of Mono Ammonium Phosphate (MAP) (11:52:0) shall also be notified separately.

4. While announcing the Base concession rates for 2007-08 (1<sup>st</sup> April, 2007 to March, 2008) to enable the manufacturers/importers to claim 'On Account' payment of concession, it was provided that the Base concession rates would be subject to the Final concession rates announced by Department of Fertilizers and in case the Final rates are lower than the Base concession rates, the lower Final concession rates would be the Base rate thereafter. Accordingly, based on the Final rates of concession announced for the month of September, 2007, the Base rate for the respective fertilizers with effect from 1<sup>st</sup> October, 2007 would be as follows:-
